Halsted Rain Exhibits New Platen Tank System at Ecobuild 2013

Halsted Rain Ltd will be launching a New Platen Tank Rainwater Harvesting System at Ecobuild 2013 to add to its existing Super Slim Wall Tank and Tower Tank range. This shallow platen unit is a fully integrated rainwater harvesting system, comprising a filter diverter; polyethylene tank storage, pump package and automatic mains water back up. The system offers the following benefits compared with conventional subterranean tanks:

- 1. Full range of tank sizes from 1500 to 7500 litres that are easy to interconnect
- Designed to be sited in a shallow excavation starting from 998 mm or under decking
- 3. Can be installed in all ground conditions without a concrete base
- 4. An integrated sump enables the most efficient use of the mains top up feature

The introduction of the New Platen System means Halsted Rain continues to set new industry standards for ease of installation, reliability and affordability. The Company's products are designed to harvest rainwater for toilet flushing and garden irrigation; and are leading the introduction of slim modular and shallow profile systems into the UK construction market.

These Rainwater Harvesting Systems are aimed at residential and light commercial users and have a storage capacity of between 440 and 7500 litres. Their state of the art design makes it easy to configure a system where space and access are restricted or poor quality ground conditions make it expensive to install a conventional subterranean tank.

Halsted Rain products have proved of particular interest to architects and developers looking for cost effective solutions to help meet the water requirement of The Code for Sustainable Homes and the new Part G Building Regulations.
