## New Flatform Tank with Stormwater Attenuation Exhibited at Ecobuild 2015

The Flatform range now includes the option of a stormwater attenuation feature that allows all or part of the tank capacity to be dedicated to helping manage site run-off through a throttle valve that can be set to the discharge rate required. The system offers the following benefits compared with conventional subterranean tank and crate systems:

- 6. Optional reinforced tank shaft and cover to provides dive-on capability
- 7. Factory fitted throttle valve set to the required discharge rate

The product range is designed to harvest rainwater for toilet flushing and garden irrigation and attenuate stormwater run-off. It is ideal for domestic and light commercial installations.
